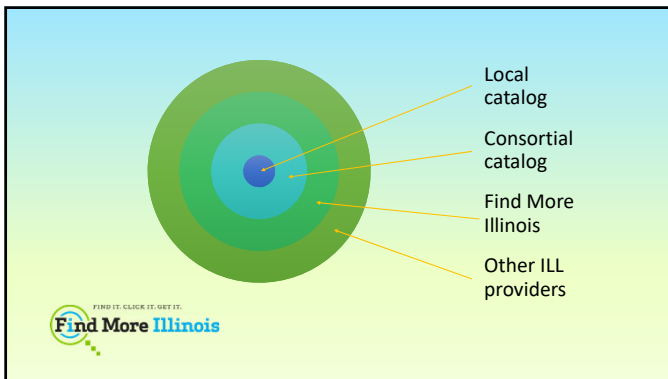





### Benefits

- Seamless discovery and delivery: find it, click it, get it
- Better interlibrary loan service, efficiency, and cost-effectiveness
- Support for reciprocal borrowing service (in development)
- Option to download MARC records
- Ability for nonautomated libraries to participate
- OCLC alternative for libraries that want one

- SHAREit (software)
- Auto-Graphics (vendor)
- Z39.50 (protocol)



## SHAREit Software

- Supports a hybrid model
  - Virtual catalog using Z39.50 connections
  - Physical union catalog
- Web-based; no software to install
- Load balancing
  - Lender lists are randomized to distribute requests among libraries with available copies

## Advantages over OCLC WorldShare ILL

- SHAREit automatically builds the lender lists
- For catalogs connected via Z39.50, there is no need to update holdings separately
- Shipping label functions as RAILS delivery label





## Costs

- Implementation fees
- Annual membership fee
- ILS vendor costs (maybe)



## Implementation Fees

- One-time cost; pass-through of vendor charges
- Per integrated library system
- Per library
- RAILS will provide customized quotes



## RAILS Assistance

- ILS implementation fee waived
  - Members of shared catalog consortia within RAILS
  - Early adopters for libraries with standalone ILS
- Library implementation fee waived
  - Libraries in first two membership tiers (paying \$250 or less annually) joining as early adopters



## Annual Membership Fee

- Scaled to make participation affordable for libraries of different sizes
- Based on total collection expenditures (all formats)
- Ranges from \$150 to \$10,000
- Libraries joining in FY2019 will lock in the same fee for FY2020



## Expansion Plans

- Initial expansion
  - Fall 2018 through winter 2019
  - Three cohort groups went live in November 2018, February 2019, and March 2019
  - Streamlined implementation and training
- Going forward
  - Sign up anytime
  - RAILS will work with you to develop an implementation schedule



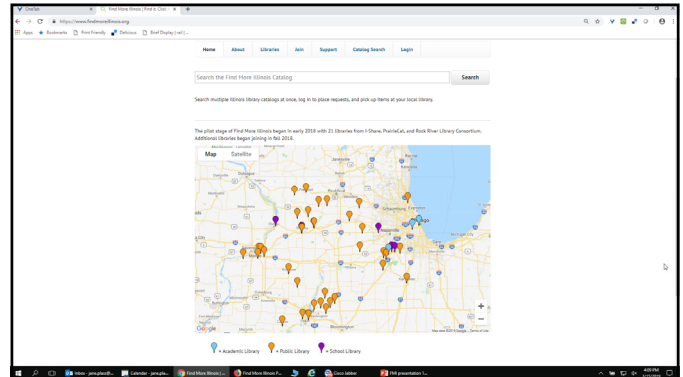
## Implementation Steps

1. Quote acceptance/letter of intent (Library)
2. Participation agreement (Library and RAILS)
3. Data collection (Library, ILS staff, and RAILS)
4. Software setup (Auto-Graphics and RAILS)
5. Training (Library and RAILS)
  - One day in-person training for library staff member
6. Integration of Find More Illinois into library's ILL workflow (Library, with advice from RAILS)

- Assistance with implementation fees
- Training and technical support

- Coordination with shared catalog consortia
